It's time to press play on your next trip to Wollongong, our glittering city bordered by mountains and ocean. With natural beauty, vibrant culture, seriously good sports, exciting events and must-see attractions, Wollongong is set to become your new favourite on-repeat destination.

Getting here and about:

Whether you prefer to travel by car, train, plane, bike or bus, choose your own adventure to explore Wollongong.

Drive: Self-drive your way into the city via the scenic Grand Pacific Drive or the convenient M1 Princes Motorway, with our CBD just 1 hour 15 minutes from Sydney.

Bus: Once you're here, explore Wollongong via our extensive bus network. Hop on and off the free GONG shuttle, linking the city's most popular beach, shopping and entertainment precincts.

Train: The train journey from Sydney to Wollongong is iconic for a reason, with bush as far as the eye can see and priceless coastal views. Sit back and enjoy the journey, then alight at one of our local stations including Thirroul, North Wollongong and Wollongong.

Bike: Hire a bike or bring your own to explore cycle-friendly tracks or cruise the coastal cycle path at your own pace.

Scooter: Hire a bright orange Neuron e-scooter, available to collect from various points around the city.

Taxi/Uber: Let someone else take the wheel with the convenience of a taxi or the flexibility of an Uber.

Fly: Arrive by air into our convenient regional Shellharbour Airport located in Albion Park Rail, with a range of domestic flight options, or take to the skies on a scenic helicopter flight.



Visitor information: Ask the experts

Find advice on where to stay, play, eat and explore at the Wollongong Visitor Information Centre inside the Southern Gateway Centre, perched atop the Illawarra Escarpment with spectacular 180 degree views. Our friendly team can assist with bookings and recommendations, or simply grab a coffee or gelato and enjoy the view. What they don't know about Wollongong isn't worth knowing!

Beaches Life's better at the beach

Can you hear it? Beach life is calling, whether you're in search of your next great wave, looking for laps in an Instagram-worthy rockpool, or ready to claim your spot on one of our stretches of golden sand. Each of our 17 patrolled beaches has its own unique charm - the only way to be sure of your favourite is to visit them all. We love:


North Wollongong Beach: A visit to Wollongong isn't complete without a trip to North 'Gong. Stroll along the Blue Mile which links the beach to the boat harbour, enjoy beachside foodie delights, take in the beautiful heritage buildings or hit the surf - this is a beach with something for everyone.

Woonona Beach: A popular spot with families who love the huge beachside playground and the Woonona Rock Pool at Collins Point to the north of the beach, a 50-metre ocean-fed pool with diving blocks and an iconic historic pavilion with endless ocean views.

Sandon Point: A curve of beach perfect for swimming and surfing, right next to a rock platform just waiting to be explored - home to sea creatures and untold treasure. Pack a picnic and enjoy the views south to Bulli Beach.

Coledale Beach: Find your chill at this quiet scenic spot, with a beachfront camping reserve, a rockpool carved into rock next to the beach, and the charm of village life at Coledale's local cafes, shops and monthly market, you can visit for a few hours or stay for the whole weekend.

Port Kembla Beach: This southside beach has golden sand stretching as far as the eye can see, as well as the iconic Port Kembla Pool - a 50 metre saltwater pool complex with something for the whole family.



Enjoy the serenity on a tour with **Stand Up Paddleboarding Shellharbour**, or catch your dinner (or a glimpse of the ocean's giants) aboard a deep sea fishing experience or whale watching tour with **Aquilla Fishing Charters**, or discover the healing power of angling with your own guided fishing experience with **Fishing With A Local**.

From our nine rock pools to the expanse of Lake Illawarra to the delights of our dog-friendly beaches and the thrill of the surf break at Sandon Point, find your happy place by the water in Wollongong.

Quick tip: City Beach is walking distance from the city-centre, and ideal for lazy beach days, cafe breaks and dolphin-spotting.









Bushwalks Adventure awaits

From rugged escarpment trails to ocean-hugging pathways and hidden waterfalls, there's a walk here for every pace and preference.

Start with one of the region's most exciting new additions: the **track from Stanwell Park to Bald Hill**. Climb 405 steps to reach this famous lookout, where sweeping views make the sweat worthwhile. This track forms part of the **Great Southern Walk**, a 67km multi-day route linking Sydney's south to **Bulli Tops**.

For a rainforest experience, lace up for the **Mount Keira Ring Track**. Winding through cool temperate rainforest, this circuit rewards walkers with bird calls, lush greenery, and breathtaking views of the city and coastline. Nearby, the **Mount Keira Summit Track** offers another way to experience the mountain's heights.

Families will love the accessible **boardwalk to Madden Falls in Dharawal National Park near Darkes Forest**. This area is of great cultural significance to the **Dharawal Aboriginal people** and home to a number of special sites. Along the way, keep your eyes peeled for birdlife, wildflowers, frogs, and reptiles.

If coastal walks are more your style, the **Grand Pacific Walk** is unmissable. This shared walking and cycling path lets you experience Wollongong's legendary shoreline up close. Cross the iconic **Sea Cliff Bridge**, then continue through seaside villages, past nature reserves, heritage pubs and golden beaches

To the north, the **Coast Track** in the **Royal National Park** offers a spectacular cliff-top journey with dramatic ocean views — just pack your water, snacks and sense of adventure.


Quick Tip: Only got an hour? The Blue Mile is a must-do when in Wollongong — by foot, bike or scooter. Start at Belmore Basin and head north to North Beach for coffee, lunch or a refreshing dip.

Lookouts Scenic and spectacular


To appreciate the epic landscapes of our region you need to get up high. Start at the **Southern Gateway Centre at Bulli Tops**, the official entry to the South Coast. Perched on the Illawarra Escarpment, this spot delivers sweeping coastal views that stretch endlessly to the north and south. Grab a scoop from **Gelato Emporium** or a meal with a side of views at **Altitude 1148**.

A little further along, **Bald Hill** is one of the Illawarra's most iconic viewpoints. From here you can take in the famous **Sea Cliff Bridge**, the beaches of Stanwell Park, and the vast Pacific Ocean. Watching the colourful hang gliders and paragliders launch from the clifftops is a must-do Wollongong experience.

Heading south, two much-loved venues offer lookouts with a difference. The heritage-listed **The Imperial at Clifton** combines history with uninterrupted ocean views, while the **Headlands Hotel at Austinmer** offers an unbeatable location.

Closer to the city centre, Flagstaff Hill is a mustvisit. Wollongong is the only point on the east coast of Australia with two lighthouses, and here you can see both framed by Wollongong Harbour and the escarpment. For a long lunch with a view, stop at Steamers Bar & Grill or The Harbourfront Seafood Restaurant.

For walkers, the **Brokers Nose Track** to the lookout gives some seriously incredible views of greater Wollongong and the Pacific Ocean, while the **Wodi Wodi Track** offers a 6.5km forest trail leading to outlooks over **Stanwell Park Beach** and the northern Illawarra coastline.




And for the ultimate perspective? Take to the skies with **Skydive Australia** or **BIGWAVE Skydive.** Why not enjoy a scenic flight with **Touchdown Helicopters**. Seeing Wollongong as you free-fall from 15,000 feet is an experience you'll never forget.

Quick tip: For a side of history with your vistas, Hill 60 at Port Kembla is a heritage-listed Aboriginal site and home to the World War II-era Illowra Battery, looking out across the southern beaches.

Embark on a culinary journey with Italian flavours at one of the local favourites - including **Restaurant Santino, Kneading Ruby,** or **II Bene** at The Fraternity Club.

Seafood is always on the menu - fresh caught and full of flavour. Savour seafood favourites at South Sailor, Lagoon Restaurant, Levendi Fish & Chippery, Bombora Seafood, Harbourfront Seafood Restaurant and ocean to plate dining at the Waterfront Tavern.

Prefer your food with a view? Try Palisade Kitchen at Novotel Wollongong Northbeach, Steamers Bar and Grill, The Imperial at Clifton, Diggies, The Boathouse North Wollongong, Georgia Rose at Shellharbour Marina and the Illawarra Yacht Club.

Why not discover Wollongong's diverse and emblematic Asian dining scene with Little Vietnam, Nam Restaurant, Mylan Restaurant and Pai Tong Thai.


Drink Crafted for good times

The secret's out about the local scene in Wollongong, with breweries, distilleries, bars, pubs and more. Relax, we've got you covered.

Whether it's an intimate moment for two or a party with your favourite people, discover unexpected venues in the Gong. Sip a signature cocktail at **Humber's** rooftop bar, take a locked room challenge at **Breakout Bar & Escape Rooms** (if you dare!), sip cocktails on the sand at **The Boathouse North Wollongong** or picture yourself lounging at the **Mount Kembla Village Hotel**, surrounded by lush trees enjoying the gentle breeze and the serene ambiance.

Relax in the heritage setting of independent brewpub **Resin Brewing** in Bulli, chill over a beer in the taproom of **Five Barrel Brewing** in the city centre, kick back with a local lager at **First Light Brewing Co**, pick your own apples at **Darkes Glenbernie Orchard** before heading home with their locally brewed cider or enjoy tastings at **Headlands Distilling Co** - home of the world's first Illawarra Plum cask whisky.

Quick tip: Try cocktails with a twist and add foodie flair at Ilu Ilu for Indian tapas, Greek mezze and specialty cocktails at The Living Room and Pepe's on the Beach for share plates and cocktails. Newly opened Bar Lina is also an excellent choice for stellar drinks paired with an intimate, music-filled atmosphere.





Cycling Ride Wollongong your way

Say hello to our cycle city! Whether you're a serious lycra-clad cyclist, a thrill-seeking mountain biker or a beach-path cruiser taking in the sights, you'll find your best ride in Wollongong.

Wollongong proudly hosted the 2022 UCI Road World Championships, with elite road races launching from Helensburgh and culminating in the city on Marine Drive. To honor this moment there are five commemorative plaques at key locations along the course. These markers serve as tangible touch points for cyclists and fans to follow the blue line tracing the route offering a way to literally follow in the wheels of the world-class athletes who raced in 2022.

Come and see for yourself what's made us a global cycling destination firsthand with clearly signposted cycle paths, more than 100 Bike Friendly Businesses, radical road cycling routes and dedicated mountain bike facilities. Welcome to pedal paradise.

BYOB: Bringing your own bike to Wollongong? We've got you covered for repairs and support - check out B-Line Bikes, Wollongong Bike Hub, Local Cycle Co, Giant Wollongong and Trek Bicycle Wollongong if you need help with punctures, parts or servicing. Bike Hire is also available (both city or mountain bikes, including e-bikes) from Giant Wollongong.


Take a tour: Not sure where to start? Check out short tours of the Gong or personalised cycle itineraries with **Cycle Tours NSW**. Or, for self-guided routes, check out our **Ride & Discover** video series on our website and **Club Wollongong** on STRAVA.

Conquer the mountain: Ready for some rugged thrills? Check out our new world-class mountain bike trails at Mount Kembla - this off-road bush wonderland will get your gears grinding in the best possible way. Or bring the whole family to Cringila Hills Mountain Bike Park with 12km of trails for riders of every level, a jump and skills park and an asphalt pump track.

Choose your own adventure: Hug the coast starting from Sea Cliff Bridge and heading south along shared pathways with million-dollar views all the way to Wollongong Harbour. Ride around Lake Illawarra to take in some of our favourite waterside locations with a stunning escarpment backdrop. Visit the closed loop Illawarra Criterium circuit — a great place to take kids or small wheels of any sort.

Quick tip: Start at Towradgi Beach and cycle south through Fairy Meadow and North Wollongong, finishing at Belmore Basin for a seafood lunch or well-earned coffee. Keep an eye out for sky divers descending from the sky over North Wollongong, or have a quick dip if the waves are calling.







Family Friendly Smiles all round

You'll find fun for all the family here in Wollongong. Burn energy in the great outdoors, make memories at playful attractions or find your new favourite day-out destination.

Action-packed attractions: If you want to feel the fear (and do it anyway), get ready to make some adrenaline-fuelled family memories here. Don't miss Jamberoo Action Park (open Oct to April) for an amazing selection of water slides and rides, from the drop of The Stinger to the thrills of The Perfect Storm and twists and turns of The Taipan. Climb into the canopy at Treetops Adventure or the Illawarra Fly Treetop Adventures where you can soar though

the ultimate aerial playground, or rev your engines and unleash your inner speed demon at C1 Speed Indoor Karting & Laser Tag. Putt putt the day away at the Illawarra Golf Complex or lace up your roller skates and hit the rink at Go Skating

Weather-proof plans: Rainy day? It's all good. We've got plenty of indoor action to keep you and your tribe busy. Check out the largest Buddhist temple in NSW at Nan Tien Temple for a dose of tranquillity (and a delicious vegetarian feast), or let your child's imagination take flight with hands-on adventures at UOW Science Space and Early Start Discovery Space. Then slow down and immerse



See the local wilderness from horseback with a trail ride at Darkes Forest Riding Ranch and Otford Farm Trails or take to the water with a tour of local waterways with Stand Up Paddle Boarding Shellharbour and Canoe and Kayak Adventures. Explore the ecosystems of Wollongong Botanic Garden where kids will love the inclusive playground.

Quick tip: Get cosy with our furry locals with a koala selfie or kangaroo-feeding session at **Symbio Wildlife Park** - if you visit in the summer be sure to bring your togs for fun at the fantastic splash park on-site.

In Wollongong, we're more than just a pretty face.

Dig a little deeper and you'll find creative expression in spades, as artists flock to our city and find inspiration in everything from the countless blues of the ocean to our iconic industrial heritage and the wild secrets of our bushland setting.

Find your 'wow' moment as you wander the city's streets and admire the murals that adorn our city's urban canvas. These jaw-dropping artworks are on a scale of their own from multi-storey facades to shopping centre walls and secret alleys. Merrigong Theatre Company curates and manages Wollongong's premier performing arts venues the Illawarra Performing Arts Centre (IPAC) and Wollongong Town Hall — offering a vibrant program of theatre, music, and cultural events.

Explore the extensive collections and seasonal exhibitions in the Wollongong Art Gallery, which houses a rich display of early Australian art, Aboriginal art, contemporary Australian art and

international pieces in the heart of the city.

Find something out of the ordinary at the **Project** Contemporary Art Space, a vibrant, inclusive multi-disciplinary art space with exhibitions, events and workshops featuring emerging, innovative and experimental artists or treat your ears to a world-class performance at the Wollongong Conservatorium of Music AKA WollCon.

Quick tip: What's old is new at HARS Aviation Museum, home to some seriously impressive aircraft, and you'll have a whole new respect for the industrial heritage of our region with a behind-the-scenes tour of the Port Kembla Steelworks at Inside Industry.

Dharawal Culture that connects

Welcome to Dharawal Country.

Get on a first name basis with our First Nations heritage as you discover the stories, art and sacred connection of the region's Aboriginal people and the local area.

This special place, where the mountains meet the sea, is rich in history, culture and storytelling that has lasted millennia.

Start at the **Dharawal Country Experience** within the Southern Gateway Centre. Here, you'll find a self-guided experience introducing you to the traditions, wisdom and culture of Dharawal country and the Wollongong (Woolyungah) region. In the learning hub, video content and audiovisual displays explain the cultural significance of the area and what Indigenous life was like here.

Marvel at impressive First Nations artworks, and then head out to the viewing platform for 180-degree views of the area, with signage to showcase local landmarks in their Indigenous names.

Head into the city centre, and at **Wollongong Art Gallery** you'll find traditional and contemporary works by hundreds of Aboriginal artists from the local area and across the country. From here, visit **Wollongong Botanic Garden** to explore the Towri Bush Tucker Garden and Towri Centre, where you can learn how local native plants were used for food, medicine and shelter by Aboriginal people.

Delve deeper into the rich cultural tapestry of our region at the **Coomaditchie Co-operative** in Warrawong, where some of the premier Aboriginal artists in the Illawarra region display their art, capturing the spirit, colours and stories of their cultural heritage.

Immerse yourself in the **Gumaraa Aboriginal Experience**, with interactive opportunities to discover Aboriginal art, music, dance and traditions, including didgeridoo playing, painting, weaving, bush tucker tasting and Aboriginal language.





Events What son in the Gong

From packed stadiums to coastal streets, Wollongong's events calendar is where sport, music, arts and culture collide in a way that keeps visitors coming back for more.

At the heart of it all, the **WIN Sports & Entertainment Centre** is Wollongong's hub for live action. From global touring musicians and comedians to high-stakes sports, there's always something to cheer for. Catch the buzz courtside with 2025 NBL Champions, the **Illawarra Hawks** or feel the roar of the crowd as the **St George-Illawarra Dragons** take the field.

The Illawarra Performing Arts Centre fuels the city's creativity year-round with theatre, dance and live performance, as festivals bring that energy outdoors. The iconic Yours & Owls Festival turns the coastline into a music mecca, while the Illawarra Folk Festival and Culture Mix keep the rhythm alive across venues, streets and stages.

For those who prefer to join the action, Wollongong's natural playground becomes an arena for iconic challenges like the **Aquathon, Wollongong Triathlon** and **Run Wollongong** marathon. As Australia's first UCI Bike City, don't miss the **Ride Wollongong Festival**, featuring cycling and mountain biking events that take riders through the region's most stunning scenery.

Elite competition is not lacking either. Watch worldclass athletes take centre stage at the Women's NSW Golf Open, Australian Shortboard Surfing Titles, CrossFit Down Under Championships and the World Series Australian Darts Masters.

Quick tip: The night doesn't need to stop when the curtain falls or the final whistle blows. Wollongong's buzzing nightlife precincts keep the energy alive with late bites, drinks and live music. For the full line-up of what's on, visit our website and start planning your trip.







Some roads are just roads. The Grand Pacific Drive? That's an experience. From the moment you roll out of Sydney and trace the coastline via the **Royal National Park** towards Wollongong, the journey takes on a life of its own. The road twists and turns past golden beaches, winds through emerald forests, and dances along clifftops that tumble dramatically into the sea.

And then, of course, there's the star of the show: the world-famous **Sea Cliff Bridge**. Suspended between towering sandstone cliffs and the endless sweep of the Pacific Ocean, it's not just a drive, it's a moment that stays with you long after the engine cools.

As you settle into the rhythm, you'll find yourself pulling over just as often as you're pressing the accelerator. Maybe it's the lure of a picnic by the ocean, a lookout that demands a photo, or a seaside village with a café that promises the perfect flat white.

The 140km drive connects you seamlessly to the best of Wollongong, Shellharbour, Kiama and the Shoalhaven. The **Grand Pacific Drive** isn't about rushing from A to B. It's about slowing down, soaking it all in, and discovering that sometimes the best part of the journey... is the journey itself.

Ready to hit the road?

Quick tip: Park at the southern end of Sea Cliff Bridge (near Coalcliff)and take a walk across the bridge — it's especially stunning during whale season, when you might spot humpbacks migrating along the coast!



Other favourite courses include The Vale Golf Course at Russell Vale, Calderwood Valley Golf Course and Port Kembla Golf Club.

It's a 'hole' lot of fun at **Helensburgh Golf Driving Range** and the **Illawarra Golf Complex**, where you can perfect your swing at the driving range or enjoy the putt putt course for a seriously fun family day out.

Quick tip: Don't let a downpour dampen your fun, head indoors to Smash Factor Indoor Golf & Bar, our region's only indoor golf centre. Play more than 800 virtual courses or use the club and ball data to refine your skills.
